## 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade Cognitive Testing

All second grade students will participate in the Cognitive Abilities Test (CogAT standardized test) on **December 3**. It is a three part assessment (number analogies, picture analogies, figure matrices ) and students do not need any advance preparation for this test. This test score is just one of several data points used as a first step screener to determine high ability programming for students. Based on the results of the CogAT assessment, students may be referred for further testing next spring. **Please have students at school on time.**
