A Note from the Health Office, Sherry Stanfield, RN and Jennifer Sloan, Health Aide

Flu season is here and everyone needs to practice healthy habits to stay well. Besides eating nutritious foods and getting enough rest, hand washing is one of the best ways to prevent the spread of germs at home and at school. Please remind your children to wash their hands with warm, soapy water before eating, after using the restroom, and anytime they blow their nose or sneeze. **If your child does become ill, please keep them at home until they are free of fever for 24 hours without the aid of medication (Tylenol/Ibuprofen). A temperature of 100.4 or higher is considered a fever.** Students should also remain at home for recent vomiting or diarrhea (3 or more loose stools in 24 hours). Students diagnosed with strep throat should stay home until they have been on antibiotics for 24 hours. This helps prevent the spread of illness. Always call your health care provider if the symptoms have not improved after a few days.

If you are cleaning out closets and find that your child has outgrown their winter clothes, please consider donating them to our health office. We are in need of both boys and girls pants. Elastic waists work best but we aren't picky! Thank you in advance!

Reminder for Snow Days & Delays: The phone alert system will be used if the school corporation closes or delays.
