A Note from your School Nurse, Sherry Stanfield, RN:

One or more cases of head lice have occurred at our school recently. Having head lice can be a huge headache for families. They are not a health hazard or a sign of uncleanliness and they do not spread disease. However, they do cause an itchy scalp and can be costly in time and money to treat. Be sure to check your child's hair frequently for signs of head lice. Signs of head lice can include:

- excessive itching, redness, or sores found on the scalp
- nits (eggs) stuck on the hair close to the scalp that will not easily come off
- live lice (bugs) often found behind the ears or back of neck that are the size of a sesame seed or smaller

Children should try to keep their heads from touching other children's heads, as this is the main way head lice spread. Also, remind children not to share hats, combs, brushes, pillows, or hair ornaments with each other.

If your child has head lice, let the school know. Use an over-the-counter or prescription head lice treatment according to the directions. Wash all recently worn clothes, all bedding including pillows, and hair care items (combs, brushes, hair clips) in hot water. Put stuffed animals in a hot dryer for 30 minutes or sealed plastic bag for

2 weeks. Let your school nurse know if you would like more information about how to treat or prevent head lice or if you would like to have your child checked for head lice.

A Note from the Health Office, Sherry Stanfield, RN and Jennifer Sloan, Health Aide

Flu season is here and everyone needs to practice healthy habits to stay well. Besides eating nutritious foods and getting enough rest, hand washing is one of the best ways to prevent the spread of germs at home and at school. Please remind your children to wash their hands with warm, soapy water before eating, after using the restroom, and anytime they blow their nose or sneeze. **If your child does become ill, please keep them at home until they are free of fever for 24 hours without the aid of medication (Tylenol/Ibuprofen). A temperature of 100.4 or higher is considered a fever.** Students should also remain at home for recent vomiting or diarrhea (3 or more loose stools in 24 hours). Students diagnosed with strep throat should stay home until they have been on antibiotics for 24 hours. This helps prevent the spread of illness. Always call your health care provider if the symptoms have not improved after a few days.
